RULES AND GENERAL TERMS

1. Definitions

1.1. These Terms and Conditions use the following definitions:

- **Event, race** - an event organized by the Race Organizer.
- **Race (event) participant or Participant** – an individual (citizen of Ukraine or foreign national) of the appropriate age, registered to participate in the Event, and possessing a physical ability to overcome a course on his/her own.
- **Race (event) Organizer or Organizer** – a legal entity registered under the legislation of Ukraine, which organizes and conducts the Event.
- **Rules** – Rules and General Terms that define conditions for participation in the race. The rules acts as an agreement between the Race Organizer and the Participant regarding the specific event for which the Participant registered. Registration for participation in the event in the order determined by the Race Organizer acts as Participant’s acceptance of these Rules and General Terms in full.
- **Registration (starting) fee** - the Participant's fee for participation in the Event. The amount depends on the selected course and payment period and is specified in the Regulations of the Event.
- **Start/finish area** – the area in front of the start/finish line. Access to the start/finish area is only available to participants, Race Organizers and service staff.
- **Official start** – the moment when a command to start is given to an individual Participant or a group of Participants who start together. The official start time is determined by the Race Organizers.
- **Closing of the start area** – the time after which the race participant is not allowed into the start and the course. The closing time of the start area is determined by the Race Organizer.
- **Closing of the finish area** – the time after which the result of the participant who came to the finish line does not count. The closing time of the finish area is determined by the Race Organizer.
- **Official Time** – the time from the moment an individual Participant or several Participants who start together are given the command to start until the Race Participant crosses the finish line.
- **Net time** – the time from the moment when the Participant crosses the start line till the moment the Participant crosses the finish line.

• **Unsportsmanlike conduct** – willful violation of the law, these Rules, Race Regulations or other acts or actions of a participant that are considered by the panel of judges as those interfering with fair conduct of the race or are contrary to moral and/or ethical standards.

2. Organizer and management of the Race

2.1. NGO “Run Ukraine” serves as the Race Organizer.

2.2. The Organizer establishes the Race Organizing Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Organizing Committee) from among its staff and engages third-party sport-specific specialists from various sports.

2.3. The Organizing Committee approves the Race Regulations as well as makes additions and amendments to the Regulations.

2.4. The Organizing Committee is responsible for:

- Information support of participants;
- Raising funds to conduct the Race;
- Preparation of documents and materials for the Mandate Committee;
- Provision of prizes to award winners and medalists of the Race;
- Provision of refereeing;
- Lease of sports facilities, premises, and technical equipment required for conducting the Race;
- Organization of security measures and medical oversight of the Race.

The Mandate Commission shall supervise the preparation and conduct of the Race, review official protests and resolve disputes, examine documents and make decisions about admission to the Race.

Chernitskyi D.L., the Race Director, serves as the Head of the Mandate Commission.

The Mandate Commission includes:

- Representative of the Organizing Committee;
- Chief Judge of the Race;
- Medical Director of the Race;
- Chief Secretary of the Race.
- Athletes Manager.

Invited professional athletes and specialists are allowed to join the commission.

3. General provisions

3.1. The Race is fully compliant with the following Technical Regulations of World Athletics, Association of International Marathons and Distance Races (AIMS), Athletics Association of Ukraine, and the rules established by the Race Organizer.

3.2. The date, place, program of the Race is determined by the Race Organizer in the Race Regulations. The Organizer may change the date, place, program of the Race at any time if public authorities and local governments in the region of the Race introduce the restrictions (including, but not limited to, quarantine and/or the introduction of anti-epidemic measures in the territory with a significant spread of acute respiratory disease COVID-19 caused by coronavirus SARS-CoV-2) which interfere with the Race.

3.3. The Race Organizer has the right to make changes to the Race program. The Race Organizer notifies the Participants of such changes in advance (as far as possible) by e-mail specified by the Participant during registration for participation in the Race and/or publishes a notice on the website of the relevant Race.

3.4. The Race Organizer (before or during the Race) has the right, and in some exceptional situations is obliged, to postpone, fully or partially reduce, completely or temporarily interrupt, partially close or cancel the Race if it is probable that the planned Race or its continuation may lead to a threat to life and health or the loss of property. In this case, the Participants under no circumstances have the right to demand a refund of the paid registration fee for participation in the Race.

3.5. The Organizer in case of force majeure and/or security reasons, and/or in the presence of any other circumstances that make it impossible to hold the Race has the right (and in case of official orders from public authorities and/or local governments is obliged) to cancel the Race in whole or in part or, if possible, postpone the Race to other date and time. At the same time, the Participants under no circumstances have the right to demand a refund of the paid registration fee for participation in the Race, and the Organizer is not responsible for the Participants' losses.

In such cases, the Organizer together with The Organizing Committee constitutes one of the following decisions:

- cancel the Race;
- exclude certain types of competitions or all types of competitions from the Event;
- change the place, time, program of the Race;
- reduce the number of Participants following the instructions of the authorities;
- change the format of the Race from "offline" to "online."

The Organizer notifies the Participants of the decision (if possible) by e-mail, which was specified by the Participant during registration for participation in the Race, and/or publishes a notice on the website of the Race.

The term "force majeure" includes (but is not limited to): war, war-like conditions, riots, strikes, lockouts, lack of energy or raw materials, revolution, uprising, military or civil coup, terror, reactor accidents, riots, embargoes, epidemics, pandemics such as COVID-19, fire, hurricane or other catastrophic storms, as well as natural events such as earthquakes and landslides.

The Organizer publishes all current information about the organization and holding of the Race, as well as any notifications of changes on the websites of the relevant Race. The Organizer is not responsible for non-acquaintance or late acquaintance with the specified information and strongly recommends the Participants regularly follow the current information on possible changes in the Race conditions.

3.6. Given that the preparation for the Race season in 2021 takes place during the "adaptive quarantine" approved by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine № 641 d.d. July 22, 2020, according to which, depending on the epidemic situation in the region or individual administrative units of the region, the "green," "yellow," "orange," or "red" level of epidemic danger of COVID-19 spread is set and depending on the level of epidemic danger certain quarantine restrictions are imposed, the Organizer considers three formats of the Race:

- **the region of the Race is located in the "green quarantine zone"** - The Race is held according to the approved program in compliance with anti-epidemic measures - "full start;"
- **the region of the Race is located in the "yellow quarantine zone"** - The Race is held in a park area or on a small track;
- **the region of the Race is located in the "orange red quarantine zone"** - The Race is held online.

The Organizer indicates specificities of the Races in each format in the Regulations of the respective Race.

3.7. By participating in the Race and signing the starter's letter (for race participants 16 years of age or younger, the starter's letter is signed by legal representatives - parents or authorized accompanying persons: coach, teacher, etc.), the Participant confirms that he/she has read all information about the Race provided by Race Organizer, understood and unreservedly agreed with all the Rules of the Race.

4. Refund of the entry fee

There is no refund of the money paid as entry fee in accordance with the Public Offer Agreement, which is accepted by the participant upon registration for the Race.

5. Personal information, collection and processing

Participants are aware that all Races organized and conducted by the Organizer are public events. They can be covered in the online media - on the Internet and/or social networks and offline media - on radio, television, and print media. Participants have to clearly understand that they can appear in photos or videos in the materials covering the Race.

The Organizer or the service providers involved on his behalf during the Race may take photos and videos and/or interview participants during sporting events. The Organizer has the right to use (or not to use) the photos, videos, and interviews taken in any way and for any purpose without any payment from the Organizer of the Race and without the prior agreement of such use with the Participants.

Participants grant the Organizer the exclusive right, unlimited in terms of time, space, and subject matter, to reproduce, distribute and publicly display photos, videos and interviews, make them available for search, in particular for commercial use, as well as for offline and Internet advertising and advertising on social networks, including use in magazines, newsletters, posters, photo and video impressions of the event, press releases, etc.

By registering to participate in the Race, each Participant of the Race automatically confirms that he agrees to the use of his personal data, photo, video, or audio materials with his participation and agrees that these materials can be used without consent to promote the event without any payment for such use by the Organizer of the Race, and by any third parties to whom the Organizer has granted the right to use them.

Participants waive their right to be named during each (including the public) use of photo, video, or audio materials with their participation.

The Race Organizer can use all photos and videos of the Race available to the Race Organizer as supporting documents confirming the accuracy of the Race results and/or cases of violation of the Race rules.

Personal data provided by Participants during registration will be stored and processed by the Organizer, and the Organizer engaged third parties involved in the organization and conduct of the Race to organize and conduct the sporting event, including printing/publication of race results and/or providing medical care of Participants on the track (course) and finish area by medical services that monitor the event, as well as to process payments.

Data processing is carried out in accordance with the requirements of the legislation of Ukraine.

In addition, the Organizer processes and publishes the surname, name, year of birth, nationality, gender, club (if any), starting number, and the result (place and time) of Participants to present lists of participants and results in the relevant media accompanying event (including the

Internet), and may transmit this data for publication to third parties and store it to create an archival database of results.

6. Costs of organizing and conducting the Race

The Race is held through the involvement of sponsors and partners and the participants' registration fees.

Given that the Registration fees of the Participants are part of the funds that are used by the Organizer to cover expenses for the organization and preparation of the Race, and without which the preparation and holding of the Race would not be possible, the refund of the paid Registration fee (both in whole or in part) is not possible under any circumstances.

Travel, accommodation and food costs are borne by sending organizations or the participants themselves.

7. Registration for the Race

7.1. Participants are allowed to enter the Race provided proper and timely registration for the Race.

7.2. The Race Organizer has the right to suspend or completely close registration for the Race without any prior notification.

7.3. Registration for the Race is performed on-line on the website of Race Organizer. The website of the Race Organizer providing registration is specified in Race regulations.

7.4. Registration for the Race is performed on-line by filling in the application form on the website of Race Organizer and paying the Registration fee.

7.5. Registration for the Race is considered completed after the full amount of the Registration fee paid by the participant is transferred to the account of the Race Organizer.

7.6. Registration is canceled automatically if the Registration fee is not paid within 3 working days after submission of application and not later than 3 working days before the day of the Race.

7.7. The total number of participants on all race courses is limited and specified by the Race Organizer on the website and in the event press release.

7.8. Registration for the Race can be closed early if Participants' total limit on all courses is reached.

7.9. On the day of the Race, registration for the Race is not possible.

7.10. By filling in the registration application, the race participants agree to collecting, storing, using, processing, and transferring to third parties of their personal data provided during the registration process - for marketing purposes of the Race Organizer.

7.11. By filling in the registration application, participants agree to the use of their personal information, photo, video, or audio materials with their participation for advertising purposes without their consent or any compensation from the Race Organizer.

7.12. When conducting competitions in the "online" format, the organizer may open a "late registration." Athletes who buy slots under these conditions will receive a Starter Pack 21 days after the race.

8. Registration fee

8.1. The Registration fee is determined by the Organizing Committee and has different prices. The Registration fee price depends on the chosen course and the payment period specified in the Race Regulations.

8.2. The Registration fee payment is carried out by electronic payment on the Race Organizer's website, specified in the Race Regulations.

8.3. The Registration fee does not include money transfer fee.

8.4. Payment of the Registration fee in cash is only possible during additional registration and sale of "Optimal Starter's Packages" along with distribution of starter packages, which will take place the day before the event, provided that the total limit of participants on all courses has not been reached.

8.5. The Registration fee paid by the Participant may be transferred to another person within the event free of charge no later than 30 days before the start of the Race.

In the 30-day period before the start of the Race, the Registration fee transfer to another person is available for a fee of 150 UAH.

The participant must purchase the Certificate of Registration fee transfer from the online store at <http://runukraine.org/shopping>.

The Participant must submit an individual application by sending a letter to registration@runukraine.org with "Registration fee transfer" in the subject line and the necessary data provided.

After the procedure, the new Participant receives a new unpersonalized race bib number with a result capturing electronic chip and everything else that is provided in the starter package for a certain course. The previous Participant's race number specified in the application is canceled.

Please, notice! There is a limited number of certificates. The service is only possible if you have this certificate.

8.6. The Registration fee paid by the Participant is non-refundable no matter the circumstances, including the following: the Participant is unable to take part in the Race, the Participant is unable to complete the course of choice, the Participant is unable to meet the set time limit, the Participant is disqualified, or the Race is canceled due to force majeure, etc.

8.7. Race Participants who have paid the Registration fee for a course on the particular Race may not transfer their application to another Race under any circumstances.

8.8. The Race Organizer has the right to change (reduce) the sum of the entry fee in case of failure to provide certain goods and services (T-shirts, food stamps, etc.).

8.9. The Organizer has the right to set the cost of the entry fee at his discretion and to change its amount at any time based on changes in the cost of goods and services provided to the Participant.

8.10. In case of holding competitions in the on-line format, the Participant is obliged to pick up the Starter Pack at the branches of Nova Poshta within 5 calendar days from the date of arrival of the parcel at the branch. If the package is not picked up during this period, it is returned to the Organizer. In this case, it is possible to receive the package either from the Organizer's office (Kyiv, 14/7 Pirogovskoho Street, office 201) or by paying a "certificate for re-shipment." The certificate is sold in the Run Ukraine store.

9. Privileged categories

9.1 Registration for pensioners (women over 59 and men over 60) is free.

9.2 Preferential registration is provided for other categories of citizens of Ukraine (30% discount from the basic cost of the Registration fee at the time of payment):

- internally displaced persons from the ATO zone;

9.3 Free registration is provided for all courses, except for charity races, but is limited not more than 2 registrations per person per calendar year for the following:

- for hostilities and war participants. The number of free registrations is limited to 30 people for Work.Ua Kyiv Half Marathon 2021, Wizz Air Kyiv City Marathon 2021, and no more than 15 people for other events.

- for people with disabilities (of 1, 2, 3 group/category). The number of free registrations is limited to 15 people for Ukrainian Majors Running League 2021 events.

If the number of privileged places is reached, there is a 35% discount from the Registration fee's basic cost.

9.4 Reduced registration for students:

- there is a discount of 35% of the basic Registration fee at the time of payment, regardless of the number of participants.

The Participant must submit an individual application by sending a letter to registration@runukraine.org with "Special category" in the subject line.

When submitting your application, please, include supporting documents according to your privileged category: a copy of your passport, pensioner's ID, combatant ID, pension ID of a person with a disability, special ID card of the internally displaced person from the ATO area.

If it is found out that the Participant wrongfully claimed a privileged category at registration, such registration is canceled without any compensation from the Race Organizer.

YOU CAN GET YOUR FREE OR DISCOUNTED STARTER'S PACKAGE ONLY UPON PRESENTATION OF THE ORIGINAL COPY OF YOUR VETERAN ID, ID OF A PERSON WITH DISABILITY, PENSIONER'S ID, OR CERTIFICATE OF AN INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSON.

10. Participant starter package

10.1. The number of starter packages is limited and determined by the Race Organizer.

10.2. The starter packages are sold on the Race Organizer's website, specified in the Race Regulations.

10.3 The number of starter packages may be changed by the Organizer.

11. Distribution of starter packages

11.1. Starting packages are distributed in the days before the date of the Race defined in the Race Regulations or sent by Nova Poshta to the branch specified in the Participant's account.

11.2. Participants who cannot pick up their starter packages the day before the Race date must notify the Race Organizer 7 days before the Race date by email specified in the Race Regulations.

11.3. There is no distribution of starter packages on the day of the Race.

11.4. Participants of the Race receive starter packs in person upon presentation of a starter letter and ID document. If the participant cannot receive the starting package in person, it can be done by a third party by providing a list of documents outlined by the Race Regulations.

11.5. The Participant of the Race who was unable to take part in the Race may receive his/her starter package within one calendar month from the day of the Race. The Participant can either pick it up directly from the Race Organizers or arrange shipment of goods by mail at his/her own

expense. After one calendar month from the day of the Race, the Organizers are not responsible for preserving the product and are entitled to dispose of it at any time.

12. Basic Rules of the Race

The Race is carried out in full compliance with technical rules of athletic competitions of World Athletics, Association of International Marathons and Distance Races (AIMS), Athletics Association of Ukraine, Technical Race Regulations, Advertising Rules and decisions of Race Organizers.

The Race Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the Race program.

12.1 Basic rules:

- The Race Organizer reserves the right to cancel the Race (before or during the event) due to weather and/or other force majeure circumstances;
- Rules and General Terms is an official document that acts as a contract between the Race Organizer and the Participant;
- Any suggestions, amendments and supplements to this document are accepted by email to the Race Organizer: registration@runukraine.org.

12.2 Health.

- Each Race Participant participates in the Race voluntarily, recognizing all possible risks to their own health during and after the Race;
- Each Participant takes personal responsibility for his/her physical condition and ability to complete the chosen Race course;
- Accident insurance, which covers participation in sports competitions on the day of the Race, is included in the participant's starter package for all courses;
- The Race Organizer is not held responsible for physical trauma, injuries, and deterioration of physical health that a participant experiences during the Race;
- The Race Organizer is not held responsible for deterioration of physical health of a participant after the Race.

12.3. Emergency during the Race

TO THE ATTENTION OF ALL PARTICIPANTS OF THE EVENT!

In case there is a warning from The State Emergency Service of Ukraine in the region of the Race (before the Race or at the day of the Race) about a possible significant deterioration of weather conditions or severe weather events (including but not limited to: earthquake, flood, hurricane, hail, cyclone, storm, lightning, and other natural disasters), threats to human life and health, the Race Organizer reserves the right in its sole discretion to take measures to ensure the

safety of Participants, spectators, fans and all who take direct or indirect participation in the Race.

The Organizing Committee of the event has developed an internal safety scale, according to which, in case of adverse weather events, the Organizing Committee will act by the agreed plan and require all participants to strictly comply with the following requirements:

1st level of emergency - wind of 7-9 meters per second - the dismantling of inflatable arches, lightweight structures (including mileage indicators), tents, promotional, and photo areas.

2nd level of emergency - wind of 9.5-10 meters per second - the dismantling of all tents, photo areas, and the crossbar of the start-finish arch.

The project manager will ask you to remove anything that may be dangerous. There is a high possibility of canceling children's courses.

The decision to hold or cancel them will be made shortly before starting the children's courses based on the present weather conditions.

3rd level of emergency - wind of 11 meters per second and more - the collegial decision commands whether to hold or cancel the event.

The composition of the board for making such a decision includes Director of the NGO "Run Ukraine" Dmytro Chernitskyi, Project Manager Ivan Tretyakov, a representative of The State Emergency Service of Ukraine in the region, a representative of the title sponsor of the Race (or another official of the company - the title sponsor of the Race).

FOLLOW THE REPORTS OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE!

13 Liability for property damage

13.1. The Race Organizer is not held responsible for any damage caused to the health and/or property of Race Participants or spectators before, during or after the Race by other Race Participants, spectators, third parties or weather conditions.

13.2. The Race Organizer is not held responsible for any damage to the health, property of Race Participants or spectators caused before, during or after the Race by actions or inactivity of the services ensuring the order of motor traffic on the route, municipal or other services servicing the Race.

14. The Race

14.1. Each Race participant must unconditionally obey the instructions of the Race Organizer, judges, medical staff and volunteers until the participant is removed from the course.

14.2. Each participant is given a race bib number, which must be visible on the chest throughout the Race.

14.3. Each Race participant must write personal information (name, contact phone number, e-mail, blood type) on the backside of the race bib number.

14.4. It is strictly forbidden to give your race bib number to another person to use it in the Race on the course of choice.

14.5. Each Race Participant must independently overcome the course of choice along the marked route, without cutting the distance, and adhere to the traffic rules of Ukraine.

14.6. Each Participant bears personal responsibility for his/her own safety while participating in the Race.

14.7. Race Participants are strictly forbidden to use technical means (bicycles, motorcycles, motorbikes, etc.) on the Race courses.

14.8. Race Participants are strictly forbidden to use "guidance" from persons who do not participate in the Race or "guidance" using technical means (bicycles, roller skates (in running), etc.) at the courses of the Race.

14.9 Participants of the Race are prohibited from participating in two courses of the Race, which start simultaneously and on the same route (half marathon and relay, marathon and relay).

15. Team Races (teams and relays 3x10+1x12,195 km; 4x21,0975 km; 2x21,0975 km; 3x5+1x6,0975 km; 4x5 km)

Mixed teams of commercial and non-profit organizations consisting of 2 or 4 people aged 14 and over are allowed to participate in the relay.

If the organization cannot find 2 or 4 members from within, it can attract volunteers.

All four members of the team are required to participate in the relay races.

A team is considered registered if its representative has filed an application form, filled in a registration form and has paid the Registration fee for the team.

Each Participant is assigned a particular relay stage upon registration. The order of participants can be changed on the website runukraine.org, in the Participant's account. During the relay race, the chip transfer procedure must only occur in a special "transfer zone."

After the Race the relay teams, which have taken places 1 through 5, must approach judges at the information tent to go through identification process. You must have an ID, your race number and wear a bracelet received in the starter package.

Violation of any of the above rules will result in disqualification of the entire team.

The result of the relay team is the result of the participant of the last, fourth, stage of the relay at the finish line.

Payment for participation in a corporate relay is made by bank transfer based on the invoice issued by the Race Organizers. The proof of payment must be sent to registration@runukraine.org no later than 10 days before the event. All questions regarding organization of the corporate relay should be sent to registration@runukraine.org.

16. Time limit

The time limit in athletic races is:

- marathon (42.195 km) - 6 hours;
- half marathon (21.0975 km) - 3 hours;
- 10 km running - 1 hour 20 minutes;
- 4.2 or 5 km running - 40 minutes;
- 4.2 km walking - 45 minutes;
- 3 km running - 25 minutes;
- 2 km running - 20 minutes;
- 100 m, 400 m, 500 m, 800 m, 1000 m, 1500 m running - no time limit

Race Participants who are unable to finish the race within the time limit are taken off the course and may continue running outside the Race route (sidewalks, pedestrian lanes, etc.), adhering to the traffic rules of Ukraine.

17. Race courses and participants age limits

The Race is open to all runners of appropriate age, regardless of gender, as required by the Race Organizer:

In athletic courses:

- marathon, half marathon: individuals - participants 18 years and older;
- 10 km and relay races - participants aged 15 and older;
- 5 km and relay races - participants aged 14 and older;

The age of a Race Participant is determined as of December 31 of the current year..

Please, notice! Participants 15-17 years old must possess parental (legal representative) consent to participate in the Race on the courses of 4.2 km, 5 km, and 10 km.

(Annex 1 or Annex 2 respectively)

The Participant can only participate in one course, according to the Race program. The only exception is Security Cup 4.2 km, which is within the general 4.2 km course. Security Cup Participants are included in the overall 4.2 km ranking and have a separate ranking for the specific Security Cup course category. The Security Cup course is not a separate course, but it is a separate category included in the general course of 4.2 km.

18. Result Scoring System

The scoring system is provided and ensured by:

- Electronic timekeeping system;
- Judges using manual timing devices only for the first 5 men and 5 women.

Race Organizers would like to notify that the electronic timekeeping system has a certified loss percentage - no more than 3% of the total number of chips.

The Race Organizing Committee does not guarantee capturing personal results of each Participant in the following cases:

- a participant attached the number incorrectly;
- a participant started the race with someone else's race bib number;
- race bib number is torn, crumpled, etc.;
- result capturing electronic chip has been demagnetized, torn, crushed, etc.;
- race bib number was lost.

Throughout the course, the race bib number must be preserved in the form in which it was received. It is strictly forbidden to remove, cover, and/or damage it (cut, bend, etc.).

The Race Organizer must publish a preliminary protocol of the Race on the event website not later than the next day after the Race.

Participants may appeal preliminary results no later than 30 minutes after the official results are published in the "Information" area and the area for Race judges.

The cost for submission of an appeal - 500 UAH (five hundred hryvnas).

In the case of satisfaction (partial satisfaction) of the appeal, the money is returned.

Protests and appeals are not considered after this deadline.

In the case of participation in the Race in the "online" format, the Participant records the result of overcoming the course using an electronic device (watch, phone, etc.) and sends it to the Organizer registration@runukraine.org.

19. Procedure of Determining Award Winners and Medalists

The award winners and medalists of the competition among athletes are determined according to the fact of finishing according to paragraph №165.24 (IAAF rules).

19.1. Each type of race has age requirements and awards. After determining the winners on each course, the Race Organizers publish Race results on the website specified in the Race Regulations.

19.2. The prize scale is determined by the Race Organizer for each course at the discretion of the Race Organizer..

Payment of monetary prizes to the determined winners of the Race is made by non-cash transfer within 7 calendar days from the day of completion of the Race. The payment is made to the winner's bank account. The monetary prize shall be paid only when the winner provides the Race Organizer with the originals and copies of his/her documents: passport, personal tax code, and complete bank card details.

A participant may be awarded late, provided that the participant did not attend the award ceremony in his or her age group. In this case, the prize is sent by mail at the Race Organizer's expense to the address specified by the participant at registration (only on the territory of Ukraine, foreign citizens pay money transfer fee at their own expense).

The Organizing Committee of the Race is not responsible for the delivery of prizes if the Participant has provided an incorrect address.

Winners and medalists receive memorable prizes.

A participant who has been awarded an absolute championship may not be awarded in his/her age group.

20. Disqualification

The panel of judges reserves the right to disqualify the Participant if:

- a participant ran under another participant's race number;
- a participant used a shortcut;
- a participant changed the advertising image on the number beyond recognition;
- a participant ran a course for which he/she was not registered;
- a participant used means of transportation (bicycle, scooter, car, etc.);
- a participant started the race before the official start;
- a participant received assistance during the Race from outsiders;
- a participant started the Race after the start area had been closed;
- a participant came to the finish line after the finish area had been closed;
- a participant did not start the Race from the start area;
- a participant ran without the official Race number;
- a participant used doping;
- a participant displayed unsportsmanlike conduct.

All photo and video materials available to the Race Organizer may be used by the Race Organizer as supporting evidence confirming the event of violation of the Race rules.

21. Information sources

Detailed information about the Race is published by the Race Organizing Committee on the official website specified in the Race Regulations.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for information from other information sources.

21. Conditions for children and adolescents participating in the Race

The person who registers the child to participate in the Race by his consent confirms that:
